WORLD TSUNAMI AWARENESS DAY



World Tsunami Awareness Day is celebrated to create awareness about this deadly disaster which has claimed more than 260,000 lives, surpassing any other natural hazard in the past 100 years. The highest number of deaths took place in the Indian Ocean at the time of the tsunami in December 2004. It took millions of lives and affected 14 countries. It is estimated that around 2,27,000 people died in Indonesia, Sri Lanka, and India alone and the hardest-hit country was Thailand.

The theme of World Tsunami Awareness Day 2021 is 'Enhancing international cooperation for developing countries to raise tsunami awareness'. The World Tsunami Awareness Day 2021 will be promoting the 'Sendai Seven Campaign' target. The campaign aims to 'substantially enhance international cooperation to developing countries through adequate and sustainable support to complement their national actions for the implementation of the present Sendai Framework by 2030'.

The NSS unit of Sree Narayana College, Chengannur also celebrated the World Tsunami day on November 5 itself. The major aim of the day was to provide an awareness to the students about the deadly disaster and things to do when this disaster occurs. For that we conducted an awareness class for our students and volunteers about the management of these disasters.
