In these meetings suggestions were given about the need for inculcation of certain skill and they are enthusiastically implemented. Suggestion and comments given by the parents are also taken in to account for future development


7 Feed Back Collection

Categories of Feedback collection


- 1. Student feedback on Faculty

Screen Picture of feedback form placed for survey




7.1 Students Feed Back on Syllabus


7.2 Easy of understanding the Syllabus


7.3 Reference Text Availability

Parent's feedback has three main objectives:


- 1. To provide parents the opportunity to comment on the quality of their ward's learning experience, as required in preparation for and as part of review process.

In order to analyze the Parents responses on syllabus various questions were asked and 51 responses were collected from the students. Each one of them is explained below.


10.1 Overall Quality of the Education in college


10.2 Opinion about the Department Staff

10.3 Opinion about Facilities and Lab



10.4 Opinion about the Transportation



facilities to college is average. Whereas, 33% respondents Option about Transportation facilities to college is poor and 25% says very Poor.




10.5 Opinion about Online Class


10.6 Teacher engaging with real life activities


10.7 Opinion about Cost of Studies

- ➤ Recorded classes were provided after the online live classes. So that students can access the classes whenever the internet facility is available.


14 Alumni Feedback 2019-2020


14.1 Do you feel proud to be associated with our college as an Alumni


14.2 How do you rate development activities organized by the Department/College/Institute for your overall development?


14.3 Are you willing to participate in the alumni activities for the development of the college?


14.4 Is the course structure relevant to progress for higher levels?




1.1 How would you evaluate the Professional ethics and Punctuality of the students


1.1 How would you evaluate Presentation Skills of students




1.2 How can be evaluate the work culture adaptability of the student




1.3 What is the level of Participation for Research and Development activities
