5.1 Policy document of the HEI for the award of scholarships and free ships

1. The college shall notify the list of Government/nongovernment scholarships. All the notifications/brochures/circulars received by the college will be prominently displayed.
2. There is a Nodal officer for Scholarship, a teaching faculty, to address the queries and to guide the students.
3. The College is registered on all Scholarship portals of Government and the duties of verification, e-verification, attestation and e-attestation are done as per procedure.
4. The College office shall process all the applications on time.
5. The information on Scholarships/institutional endowments is also provided in the college website.
6. It shall be the duty of students to register and apply for the available scholarship as per eligibility criteria.
7. Institutional endowments shall be disbursed to the eligible students by the College based on the endowment guidelines.

Institutional Endowments Guidelines

1. KANNANPARAMBIL KUNJACHAN MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT

An endowment is instituted by Sri. K N Karunakaran in the name of his beloved father Sri Kunjachan, Kannampambil, Neduvaramcode. The interest on the endowment is awarded to the student who secures first place in arts, science, and commerce at the degree level in the university examination.

2. Sri V K JOHN MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT

An endowment has been instituted in memory of the late Sri V K John, Head of the Department of Physical Education, who expired in July 97. To commemorate the service rendered by Sri V K John, the endowment is instituted jointly by his wife Smt. Annie John and the staff and students of the college. From the accrued interest two cash awards are given annually to

1. Athletic Champion (Men)
2. Athletic Champion (Women)

3. Sri. SULTHAN SHA MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT

An endowment of Rs. 1000/- has been instituted in memory of the late Sri. Sulthan Sha, a student of B Sc Mathematics, jointly by his teachers, friends, and his father from 2021 onwards.
