

#### **DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS**

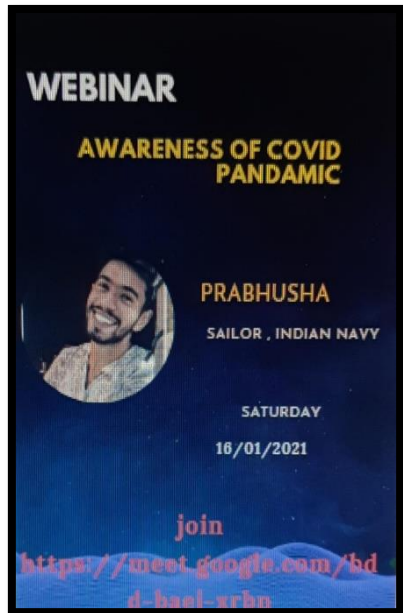

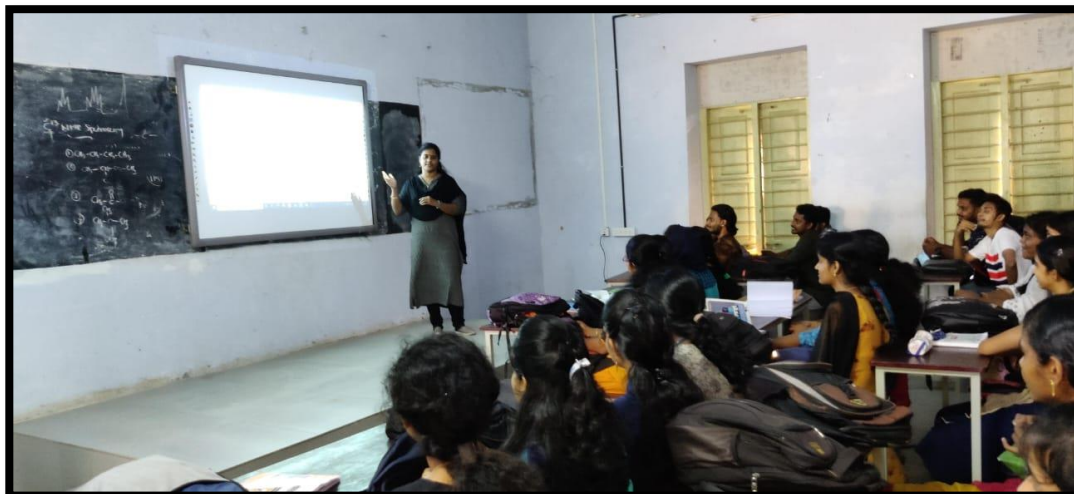

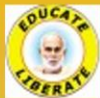
