# REPORT ON INFRASTRUCTURE REJUVENATION AND DEVELOPMENT (INFRARED)

INFRARED is one of the successfully implemented Strategic goals envisaged for the rejuvenation and construction of infrastructure for sustainable development; which has facilitated excellent academic ecosystem for higher learning in our college.
