REPORT ON INFRASTRUCTURE REJUVENATION AND DEVELOPMENT (INFRARED)

INFRARED is one of the successfully implemented Strategic goals envisaged for the rejuvenation and construction of infrastructure for sustainable development; which has facilitated excellent academic ecosystem for higher learning in our college. This plan was formulated under the prime area namely "Strengthening of basic physical facilities" under the strategic plan 2016- 2025; which has been a major recommendation of the last NAAC accreditation team for improvement.
