
Environment & Sustainable Development Mission Launch by 'Sastra Foundations'- OnlineLecture (5/6/22)


Reading Challenge


Kargil Vijay Diwas (26/7/23)

WOMEN'S EQUALITY DAY (26/8/23)



Health and Wellness Session









One Day Workshop on Data Science using R and Python (30/8/22)


Anti Drugs Campaign





Entrepreneurial Opportunities & Prospects in Kerala. This webinar provided an opportunity for our students to listen and interact with the key personalities in this field.




RENDEZVOUS with GRANDEUR- Lecture Sereies (3) -13/1/23






E-waste recycling programme (21-31st March 23)




"Career aspects of science related subjects" was organized by the Department of Mathematics on 23/3/2023 as a part of the World Mathematics Day celebration.

International Yoga Day celebration 2022 (21/6/22)


Department of Physical Education in association with Health and Sports Club organized International Yoga Day celebration on 21st June 2022. Both UG and PG students and staffs

Voluntary Blood Donation Awareness Date :- 25th July 2021






Hiroshima Day Date :- 06th August 2021



The Dept. of Economics, Sree Narayana College, Chengannur, and The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, Chennai in collaboration with National Institute of Disaster Management, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India had conducted a three day National Online training programme on "Venom Hazard management and Best Practices" from 11 to 13th August, 2021. In the very outset of the programme, the welcome address was delivered by Smt. Sreedevi Gopalakrishnan, HoD, Dept. of Economics, Sree Narayana College, Chengannur. Subsequently, the inaugural address was made by the honorable Principal, Smt. Shereen K, Sree Narayana College, Chengannur. Further, the felicitation was conveyed by Prof. (Dr.) K S Sarwani, The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University, Chennai and Dr. Ajinder Walia, Assistant professor, NIDM, New Delhi and Smt. Vani Jayadevan, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Economics, Sree Narayana College, Chengannur expressed the vote of thanks. Inaugural session was followed by the technical sessions where in all the participants had the opportunity to listen to eminent panelists affiliated to reputed academic institutions and research centers from different parts of our country. The technical sessions started with the

presentation of Dr. Dileep Kumar R, Chairman of Indriyam Biologics Pvt. Ltd. Second day of the training programme, started with lecture of Miss. R RSenjiLaxme, Ph.D. Scholar, IISC, Bangalore. She had discussed about the complications of snake bite in human body and the production of commercial Indian Antivenom were borrowed from Tamil Nadu. In her presentation, she stressed that venom will vary between the species as well as within the species and it also varies upon the life style of snake. After that Dr. VV Pillai, Chief at poison control center and Professor of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, AIMS, Cochin, Kerala has made his presentation. He mainly focused on the treatment protocols associated with snake envenomation. Third day of the training programme, begins with the session was handled by Dr. S R Chandramouli from Pondicherry University. He discussed the major identifying features of venomous and non-venomous snakes. He shared the information and concern that India is a country which is prone to high number of snake bites and related issues every year especially in rural areas. Next session was handled by Dr. Haritha Devi, Research Director, The Tamil Nadu Dr Ambedkar Law University, Chennai. Her lecture mainly focusses on the legal provisions in transmitting the traditional ecological knowledge into knowledge economy and she argues that assigning intellectual property rights will empower the indigenous community. She emphasized the importance of traditional knowledge in the treatment of snake bite and its documentation would be beneficial to the mankind and it can also be monetized. Further, lecture was given by Dr. P Sakthivel, Assistant Professor from The Tamil Nadu Dr Ambedkar Law University, Chennai. The central point of discussion was on the health economic and policy perspectives of antivenom initiatives. The final presentation of the training programme was made by Mr. Jose Louise, Deputy Director from World wildlife Trust of India. The focus of his lecture was to incorporate technology in delivering information regarding snake bites, its nature and mitigation. He introduced a mobile app, 'SARP' for tracing out the incidence of snake bite and related rescue measures. The three day training programme on "Venom Hazard management and Best Practices" ends with the subsequent valedictory session which includes rapporteurs report and vote of thanks.

Student palliative care in our college had inaugurated by our College Principal Ms. Sherin K. All the teachers and other staffs of Sree Narayana College, Chengannur had supported to complete this project



HOME VISITS

After unit, district and university level training our volunteers got the participant certificate and they formed a cell in our college for palliative care. In the NSS camp our cell organization members take an orientation class started by the volunteers. When we execute our plan into the action we took ward 4,2,3,8,1 of Cheriyanad Panchayath in Alappuzha for our project. From this word we have selected the eligible persons and done our best to them. A small group of volunteers collect the details of patients who must have the palliative care near to the college. The NSS volunteers (unit no: 49a&b) of our college have organized a palliative care program on 21st and 22nd December 2021, 2pm to 5:30pm. They are divided into two groups to interact with the patient's and bystanders home through this programme. The spirit of palliative care can have a positive effect on the patients and on our team volunteers. The program was led by NSS volunteer Dhanya P S, Sreelekshmi , in the presence of volunteer secretary Avani Suseelan, Abin A and other volunteers .Then we got best support from our program officers Dr. Nishad .A & Smt. Bindu .VK, and the practical support and guidance were from Cheriyanad FHC Palliative nurse Bindu Udayakumar.



The main objective of SIP is to those under the tight grip of deadly disease, struggling with pain and living in a dark room is extended a helping hand and brought out into the light and the bedridden are supported and sheltered and the tears and troubles of the people, the one who are suffering, in pain and those in hunger will be assisted by the members of the Students Initiative in Palliative Care Unit to relieve their troubles. On the 20th and 21st January 2022, from morning onwards we have started the activity at 10:00am and the same day, we started our practical sessions from 1.30 pm to 5:30 pm. Our action team was actually done their job very happily and they all are excited to do this project as their own responsibility in the pandemic situation. Patients in the ward close to the college were given the high priority. We have completed this mission considering all the eligible families.

SUPPLY OF MEDICINES

The goal of palliative care is to relieve the suffering of patients and their families by the comprehensive diagnosis and treatment. By engaging students in palliative care, their energy can be utilized for the benefit of patients with chronic disease and their participation will inculcate the spirit of care and positive effect. Student Palliative Care links the local palliative care units, which function in different parts of the local areas, by which students are becoming active volunteers in fund collection and home care. Our NSS Volunteers had promised to support the patients by selling products made by patients to raise the fund. For this our NSS Volunteers are planning to do the campaign in selected areas to spread the concept of helping palliative patients and the relevance of society to support the helpless patients.



The third group of volunteers prepared the medical facilities including medicines, diapers stretching ball, stretching band etc., and the fourth group taken the responsibility of preparing the food kit. Then the fifth group of volunteers had provided the transportation facilities, and the palliative care cell coordinators of our college, program officers, palliative care nurse, and Asha works had helped us to reach out to the patients. Another group of volunteers rechecked the data of palliative care patients and conducted the survey. Thereby we can understand the patient's situation and can suggest solution to their problems. Through the survey palliative care volunteers got a better idea regarding the problems of the patients.


Organised webinar on "IDENTIFYING A RESEARCH PROBLEM" (22/1/22)


"Chemfiesta 2k22" on 11/3/22

A poster making competition was organized by the department of Mathematics on 23/3/2022 as a part of the World Mathematics Day celebration.






"SCIFARI"- an intercollegiate science quiz competition (11/3/22)


WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (2020 JUNE 5)

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (JUNE 21)



HIROSHIMA DAY PAINTING COMPETITION 06/08/2020








QUIT INDIA DAY: E-QUIZ COMPETITION 08/08/2020




Flag hoisting on Independence Day




CHILDREN'S DAY DRAWING COMPETITION 14/11/2020

WORLD AIDS DAY (DECEMBER 1)




INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY (DECEMBER 10)




MARTYRS DAY – WEBINAR 30/01/2021

"WORLD WATER DAY": WEBINAR 20/03/2021






As whatsapp group was created for the drawing competition. Many students participated in the competition and shared their drawings in the group. One among the drawing was selected for prize.

WORLD POPULATION DAY (11/7/19)






