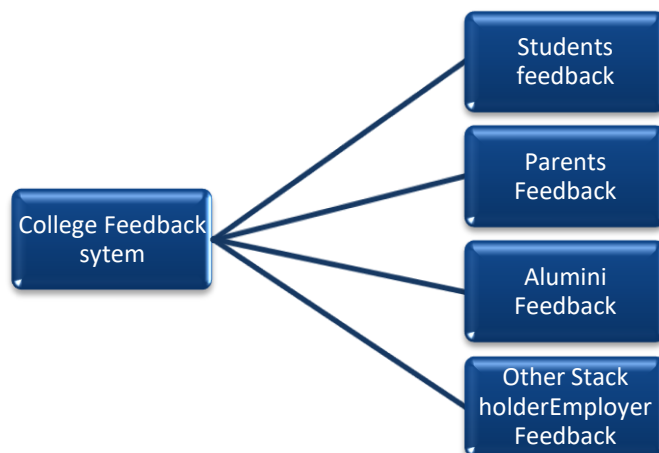
The different feedback form has been place in the Google form format and shared to students, alumni's, The same has been filled and send by responders through same form and response will called in Google data base with time stamp .
