NATIONALSERVICE SCHEME (N.S.S.)

Kerala University Intercollegiate Fencing Championship (11th December 2018)

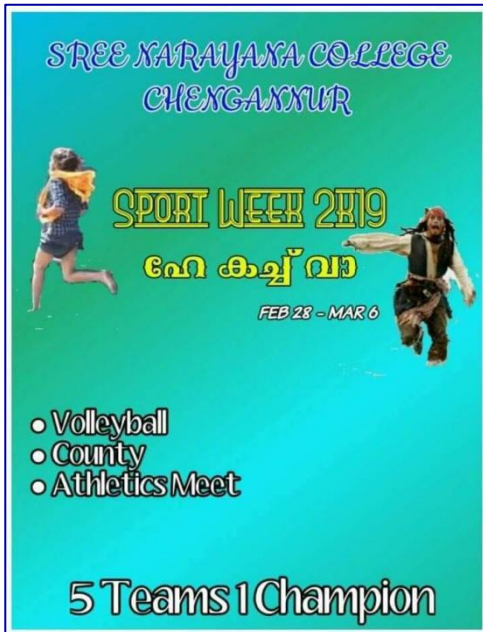
