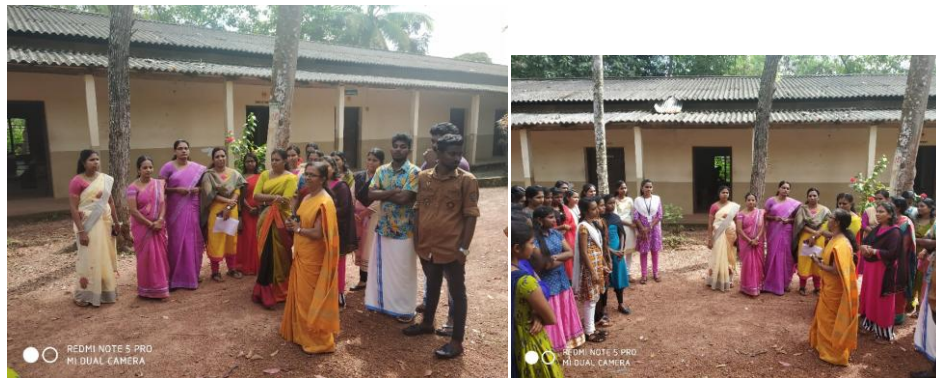
20. World Aids Day 1/12/19

A seminar on “Kathakaliyum Malayala Bhashayum”

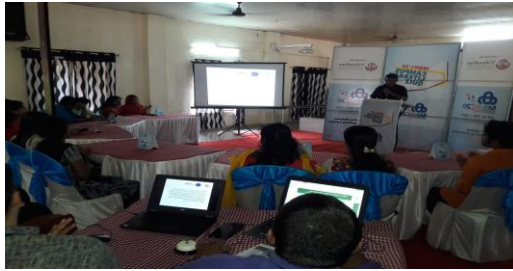
