Activities Conducted

A. Portal Registration & Training on 23/07/2024,02/08/2024 & 09/08/2024

- Volunteers guided local residents through the process of registering on the Digi Keralam Portal.
- Training sessions focused on teaching participants how to access key services such as government schemes, educational resources, online health consultations, and digital banking.
- Volunteers provided one-on-one support to ensure that each individual was able to complete the registration successfully.

- B. Digital Services Awareness Survey on 10/08/2024
 - A survey was conducted among the residents of Ward 3 to assess their current level of digital literacy and their familiarity with online services.
 - The survey covered awareness of services in areas such as education, health, banking, and government e-services.
 - Data was collected to identify gaps in digital knowledge and areas where further training might be needed.
