

8.CAKE CHALLENGE (22/12/22)












17. ECSPECTATIONS 2023 & Official Launching of "EARN WHILE LEARN"




2. POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION



7. CHILDREN'S DAY 14TH NOVEMBER 2021



a quiz competition on November 14 itself. Many students and volunteers participated in the programmes and shared their drawings and opinions about the day through online medium.




8. WORLD AIDS DAY 1ST DECEMBER 2021




16. POSTER MAKING COMPETITION




1. INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (JUNE 21)


2. INDEPENDENCE DAY (15th August)


5. CHILDREN'S DAY DRAWING COMPETITION 14/11/2020








REPORT OF THE CULTURAL AND SPORTS EVENTS 2018-2019 Cultural Programmes


<u>11.QUIZ COMPETITION (25th January 2019)</u></u>

13. ARTS FESTIVAL "AKAM 2K19" (12TH -15TH MARCH 2019)




