1. Preparation of Biodata and open Interview

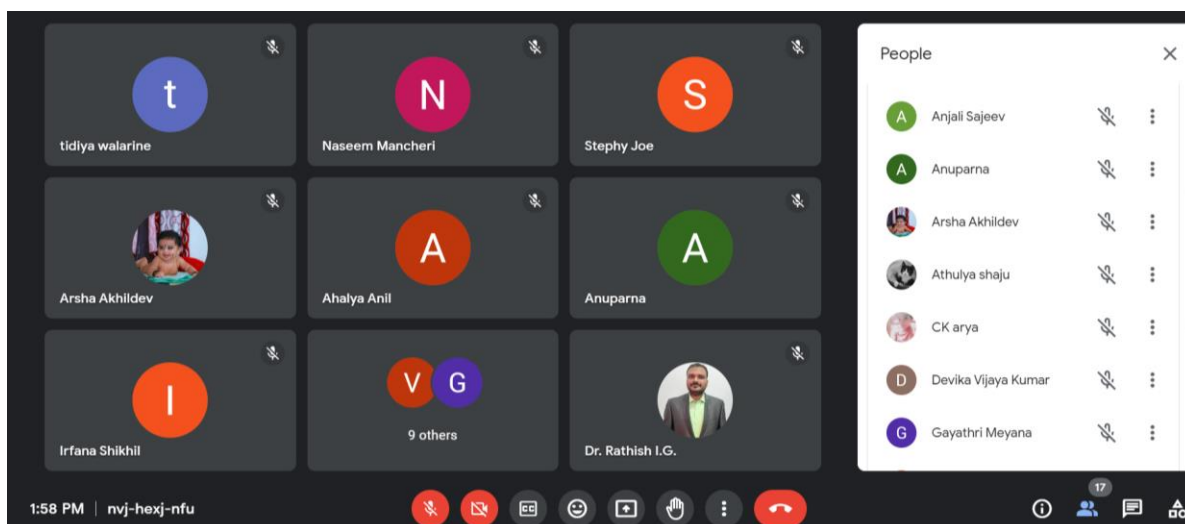

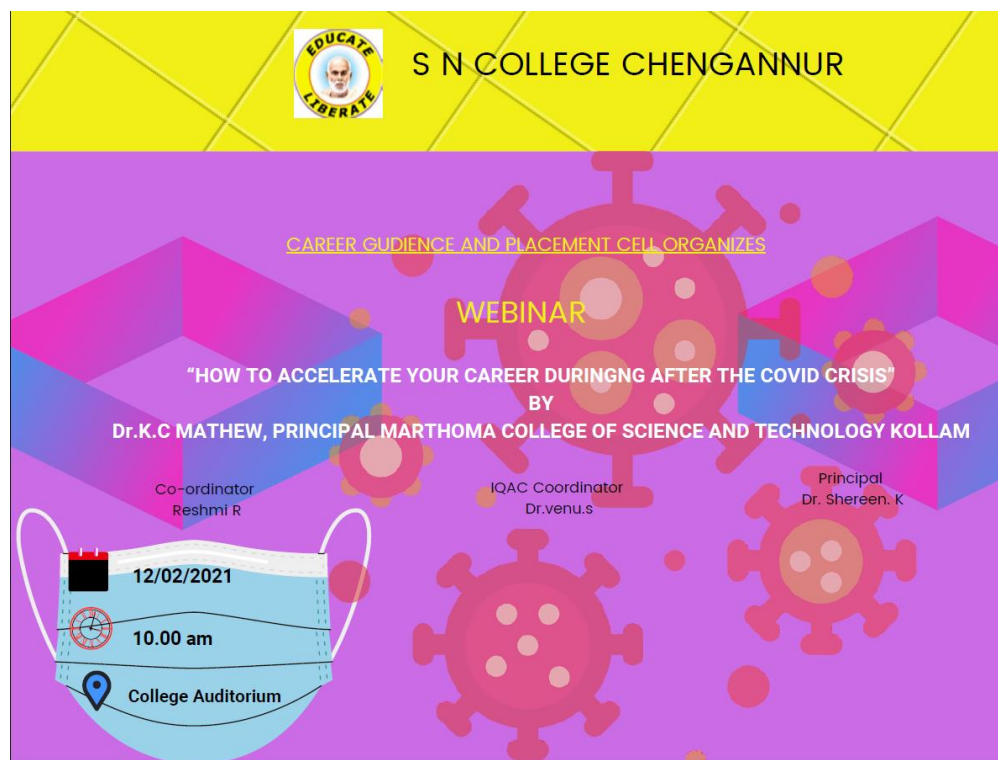

Mathew then discussed a number of strategies for accelerating your career during and after the COVID crisis. These strategies included:

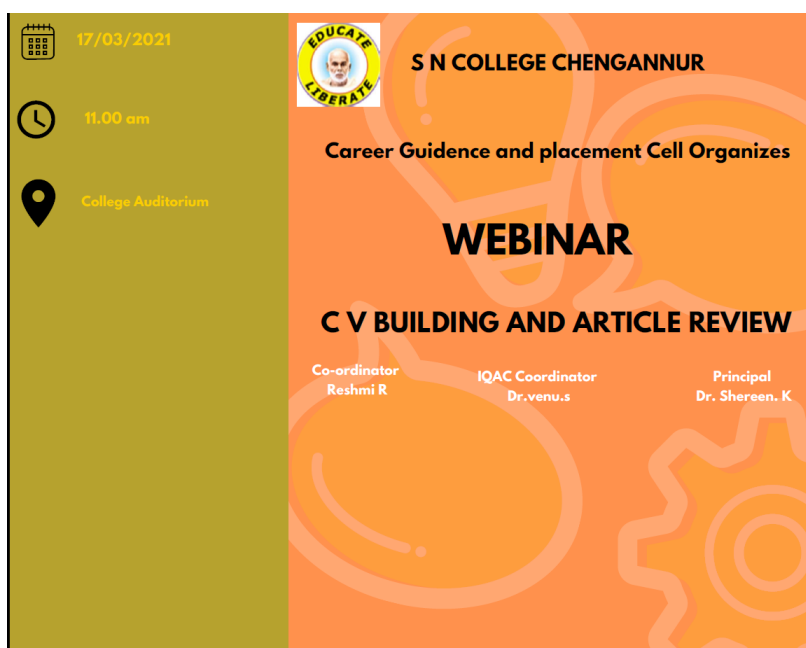




5. Motivation and Personality Development
