Feedback Collection

The Feedback collection will carry out in different level, the first level in college level feedback mainly college alumni and public suggestion is formally taken through alumni meeting and public suggestion raised in the public integration meeting held in the college. There suggestions are in to consideration for the overall development of the institution. The second level of feedback collection is in the college department level, mainly in academics and teaching. The department assigned tutors will collect the feedback from students about academics. This feedback will be discussed in department staff meeting if it found related to the college council the same will be directed to the college council. The third level of feedback collection is in student level. General and class wise PTA meetings held regularly to facilitate interaction with parents and provide the feedback form to the parents. In these meetings suggestions were given about the need for inculcation of certain skills and those are enthusiastically implemented. Suggestions and comments given by the parents are also taken in to account for future development

Feedback Analysis

The proposals regarding the analysis given by different committees and departments are discussed in council meetings of the college for taking necessary actions. The opinion provided by the stakeholders were systematically categorized and grouped for further scrutiny and analysis. Based on the consolidated feedback, the IQAC initiated steps to address the issues raised from the various stakeholders and to sustain practices found beneficial

Action taken on feedback

Based on the feedback action taken in the college level

1. To improve the quality of academic ,make the details of the syllabus which is understandable to the students
2. To arrange the additional discussion for the portion which found required improvement
3. Identify the student who have skills for specific area and support them

4. Encouraging students to join in government-sponsored initiatives like ASAP(Additional Skill Acquisition Programme), Walk with Scholar, Scholar Support program
5. Encourage students for inter college competitions.

5 General structure of Feedback system Process



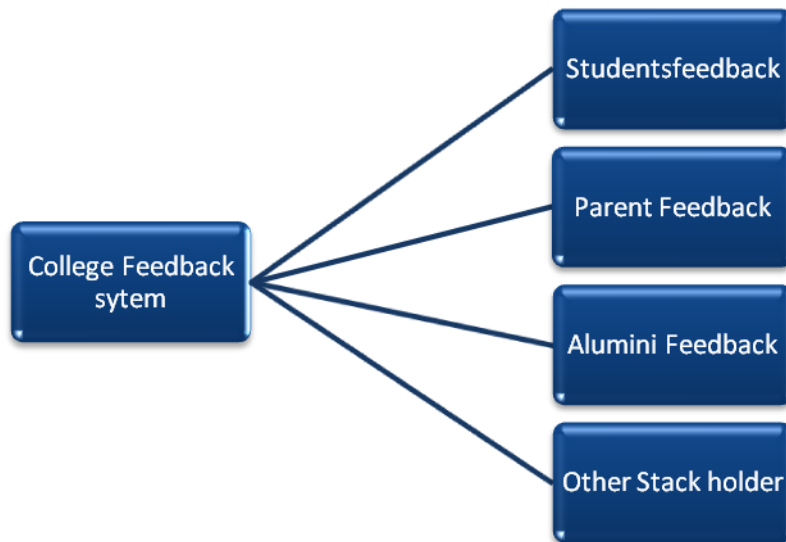
6 Feed Back Collection

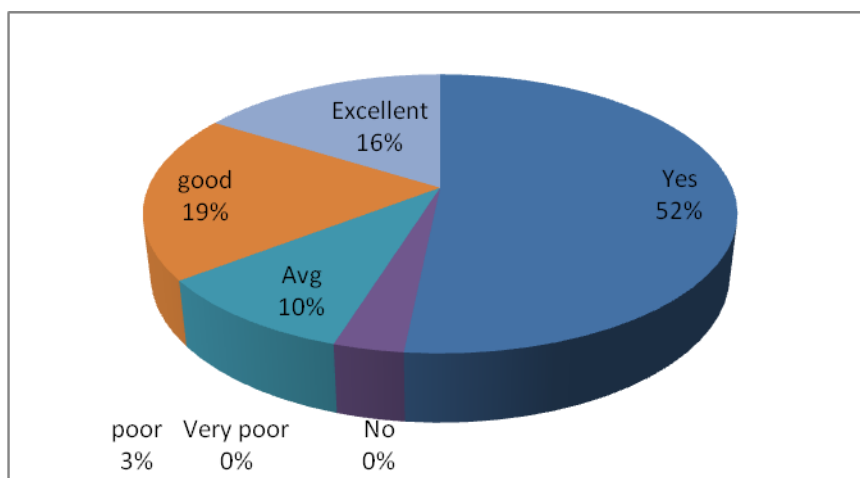
7 Alumni Feedback 2020-21

Alumni's generate invaluable contributions to the institute by their social and professional networks. Once they enter the work force they make good judgments about the course they did its content, its relevance and its applicability in real life situations. From this, we pooled information from the alumni and their feedback.

We collect feedbacks from our Alumni personally. We have designed a special feedback form on curriculum development. We are also collecting feedback from Alumni on Course Content, Teaching Learning Process, Curriculum /Syllabus / Evaluation process, Library/ Sports/others and Administration. It is the tradition of the college to involve alumni in its activities. We believe that alumni feedback is an important source of information for betterment and development of the institution. We started collecting curriculum feedback from the Academic Year 2018-19. In order to analyze the alumni feedback on various questions were asked and 31 responses were collected from the students. Each one of them is explained below.

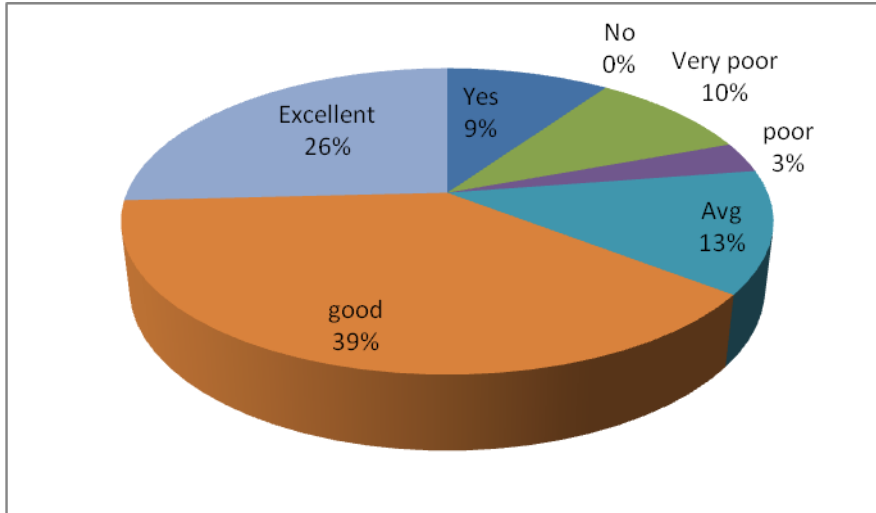
7.1 Do you feel proud to be associated with our college as an Alumni

Total number of responses received from alumni about How to feel proud to be associated with our college is 31. It was observed that, 52% of alumni's feel that they proud to be associated with our college as an alumni, 16% and 19% of response said that, they feel excellent and good. Whereas, 10% stating it's feel average, 3% feel that they are not feeling proud to be associated with our college.



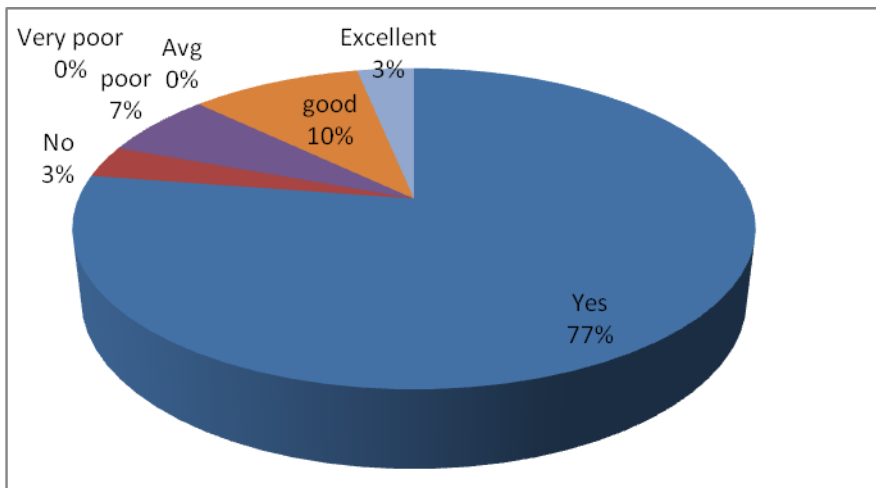
7.2 How do you rate development activities organized by the Department/College/Institute for your overall development?

Total 31 number of alumni rated development activities organized by the Department/College/Institute. It was observed that, 26% of Alumni are rated excellent and 39%, rated as good, 13% rated only average . Whereas, 3% rated as Poor and 10% rate as very poor.



7.3 Are you willing to participate in the alumni activities for the development of the college?

Total 31 number of Alumni responded about Willingness alumni activities in the development of the college. It was observed that, 77 % alumni are willing to participate in the alumni activities for the development of the college. Where 3% of Alumni are responded that they are not willing to the activities on participation of alumni's

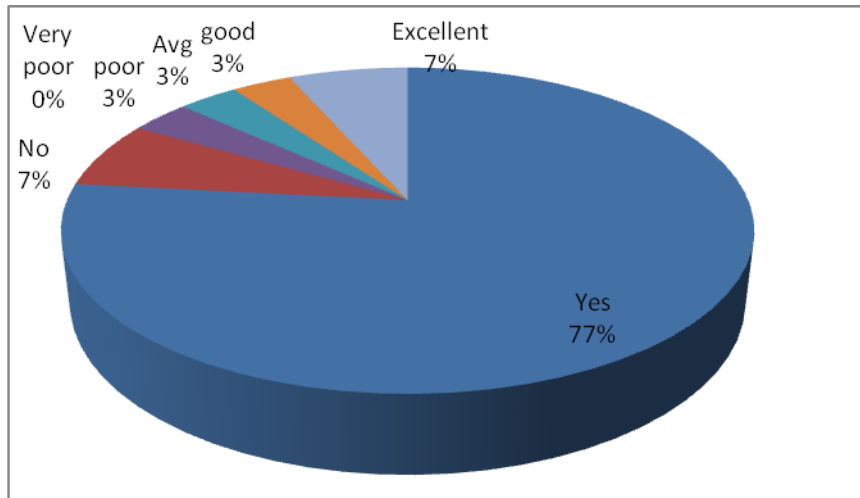

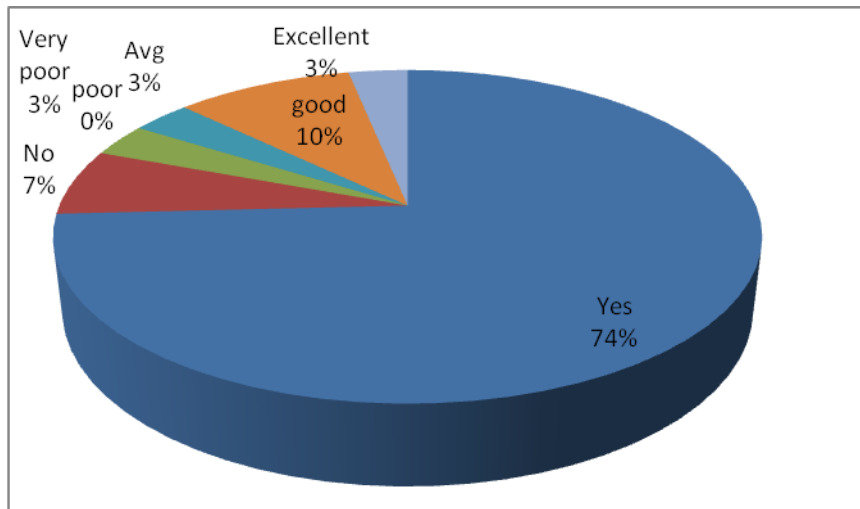
course structure relevant to progress for higher levels?

Total number of 31 Alumni responded the question about the course structure relevant to the progress for higher level. It was observed that, 77% responded that course structure were relevant to their progress. Where 14% respond that it influences only average level only, 6% respond that course structure not relevant to progress for higher levels



7.5 Is the course design applicable to real life situation?

Total 31 numbers of alumni respond the question about the course design applicable to the real life. It was observed that, 74% responded that the course design applicable to their real life, 10% rated greatly applicable in their real life where 7% said poor applicable and 3% said very poor applicable
