- An urgent meeting of IQAC was convoked in the circumstances of alarming spread of Covid-19 pandemic. The principal, Dr. Nisha J Tharayil detailed out the communications/orders from the higher education and Universities regarding the wide spread of covid-19.
- It was decided to suspend all the regular classes in the campus and switchover to the online teaching mode. However regular examinations will be conducted in the campus, strictly adhering to the covid protocol and as per the direction of the University.
- It was decided to carry out an extension activity regarding this pandemic, under the auspices of department of chemistry.
- IQAC insisted all the teachers to carryout regular classes via virtual class rooms and online mode.
- In this regard, it was decided to carry out an in-house training programme for the teachers to create a video; including recording, editing and uploading.
- Teachers of all the departments were encouraged/directed to attend as well as to carryout training programmes on online teaching-learning process.
- Teachers were encouraged to participate in online teaching programmes supervised by the government agencies/companies like Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP).
- It was decided in the meeting to carry out an online workshop/seminar on Moodle-Learning Management System.
- The IQAC strongly recommended the need for a centralized Moodle-Learning Management System (LMS) for the college.
- The IQAC, based on the report obtained from the PG departments, strongly suggested to provide coaching to the PG students, in a more organized and systematic way, to make them equipped to attend and clear the National level competitive examinations like CSIR,

# Action Taken Report on the meeting held on 11th March 2020

All the regular classes were conducted via online mode and the reports of the same on a weekly basis are submitted to the college principal and the copy of the same is forwarded to Dy.DCE.

On 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020, under the supervision of the department of chemistry, sanitizer (hand sanitizer) was prepared in significant amount and was distributed to various government offices- Police station, Fire stations, Treasury etc and various local bodies as well as to the local areas.

Under the supervision of the department of chemistry, hand sanitizer was provided to the students appearing for regular university examinations.

All the departments duly forwarded the online class reports to the head of the institution in prescribed format.

The IQAC, carried out an in-house training programme to the teachers for acquainting them to various video recording and editing platforms and to upload the same to the public platform.

Almost all the teachers of the college underwent refresher and training programmes related to the online teaching-learning, LMS and Moodle platforms.

A few teachers have prepared and presented video on online platform for several teachers" associations and government undertaking programmes/companies/agencies.

A five-day FDP was organized by Department of Physics in association with Spoken Tutorial, IIT Bombay on Moodle - Learning Management System from 25 -29 May 2020. One of the students (Vishnu) from the PG department of Physics, qualified the GATE examination (with an all India rank of 1788), in March 2020.

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
