

Report of FYUGP – Online Orientation Class for College Teachers on 28-06-2024

This programme can encourage research aptitude in students from degree level itself. The orientation put an end to the eternal questions on workload as the Minister promised that every permanent teacher's workload and job space will be protected. The Minister's talk was followed by two sessions delivered by dignitaries from the reform cell who discussed the technical aspects of the Four-Year Degree Programme.
